In an effort toward bridging the gap between the hearing and deaf communities, Sheree paired Deaf and Hearing Actresses in tandem for a theatrical production of the play "For Colored Girls Who Considered Suicide When The Rainbow Was Enuf" by Ntozake Shange. The production was nominated for five NAACP Theatre Awards and won for "Best Ensemble."

Sheree produced a Celebrity Bachelor Auction, called "Adam meets Eve." Sheree asked 25 of her single actor friends to support by allowing her to auction off dinner dates with them to single women. Some of Hollywood's hottest actors, athletes and professionals were among the participants.

Sheree came across an ad in the newspaper that "The Tyra Banks Show" was conducting a male model search nationwide. At the time, Sheree represented, Floyd McClain, a deaf model. One of the audition judges was TV News personality, Jillian Barberie-Reynolds who fell in love with Floyd. He was interviewed on camera and a day later we received a call that Tyra Banks had selected only 6 men out of 600 seen nationwide, and that Floyd was one of the six and Tyra picked him herself.

In 2008, Deafinit Models & Talent Management was launched representing Deaf Men, Woman and Children nationwide and internationally. The company has a fan base f in 19 countries and the fanpage averages 65,000 views per month.

Deafinit Models have booked work with major brands such as SPRINT, ATT, VERIZON, WELLS FARGO. In-store fashion shows for designer TRINA TURK and BANANA REPUBLIC; Catalog work for "CHILA FOR FUN"; Editorial photo shoots with notable fashion photographers; JEN STARR, PATRICK HOELK, STEPHANE TOURNE, and GINA SILVA.

Models have appeared in music videos and on televisions shows; "CSI LAS VEGAS", "BORN TO DANCE" and regularly on ABC Family's current hit show "SWITCHED AT BIRTH."
